## **POWERS OF THE BOARD** Powers and functions As per section 15(2) of the School of Planning and Architecture Act, 2014, without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (1), the Board of every School shall have the following powers, namely:-(a) take decisions on questions of policy relating to the administration and working of the School; (b) establish departments, faculties or schools of studies and initiate programmes or courses of study at the School: (c) make Statues governing the administration, management and operations of such School; (d) appoint persons to academic and non-academic section of the School: (e) consider and modify or cancel Ordinances; (f) consider and pass resolutions on the annual report, the audited accounts and the budget estimates of the School for the next financial year as it thinks fit and submit them to the Council together with a statement of its development plans: g) provide, by Statues, the qualifications, criteria and processes for appointment to teaching and other posts in such School: h) exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be conferred or imposed upon it by this Act or the Statues. (3) The Board shall have the power to appoint such committees, as it considers necessary for the exercise of its powers and the performance of its duties under this Act. (4) The Board shall conduct an annual review of the performance of the Director with specific reference to his leadership in the context of the achievement of the objects of the School. (5) The Board shall in exercise of powers and discharge of functions strive, to the extent possible, to provide autonomy in academic matters to the Senate and Departments or Faculties or Schools, as the case may be. (6) Where in the opinion of the Director or the Chairperson, the situation is so emergent that an immediate decision needs to be taken in the interest of the School, the Chairperson, on the recommendation of the Director may issue such orders as may be necessary, recording the grounds in his opinion: Provided that such orders shall be submitted for ratification of the Board in the next meeting. As per Statute 5 of the School of Planning and Architecture Statute, 2016, in addition to the powers provided under sub-section (1) of section 15 of the SPA Act, 2014, the Board shall be empowered to:re-designate or change the nomenclature of any post in the School; except for posts mentioned in the Act; (ii) approve appointments to temporary vacancies of any academic staff: (iii) specify the manner of appointment to temporary vacancies of academic staff: (iv) provide for the appointment of visiting professors. Emeritus Professors and Fellows and determine the terms and conditions of such appointments:

(ix) make, modify and cancel, if required, all or any ordinances on the recommendations of the Senate or Finance Committee of the

(viii) make, modify or cancel the Statutes with the approval of the Visitor from time to time:

School subject to the condition that making, modification and cancellation shall not be in contravention of the Act and (or) Statutes.

## **POWER OF THE SENATE**

Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 17 of the SPA Act, 2014, the Senate shall have the following powers, namely:-

- (a) to specify the criteria and process for admission to courses or programmes of study offered by the School:
- (b) to recommend to the Board for creation of teaching and other academic posts, determination of the number and emoluments of such posts and defining the duties and conditions of service of teachers and other academic posts;
  - (c) to recommend to the Board for the commencement of new programmes and courses of study;
  - (d) to specify the broad academic content of programmes and courses of study and to undertake modifications therein;
  - (e) to specify the academic calendar and approve grant of degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions or titles;
  - (f) to exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions as may be assigned to it, by Statues or by the Board.

In addition to the powers provided in the Act, the Senate shall have the powers to, as per Statute 8 of the School of Planning and Architecture Statute, 2016, as under:-

- (i) frame and revise curricula and syllabi for the courses of studies for the various Departments and Centres.
- (ii) make arrangements for the conduct of examinations, appointment of examiners, moderators, tabulators and other matters relating to the examinations:
- (iii) declare the results of the examinations or to appoint Committees or Officers to do so and to make recommendations to the Board regarding conferment or grant of degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions or titles:
- (iv) appoint Advisory Committees or Expert Committees or both for the Departments or Centres of the School to make recommendations on academic matters connected with the working of the Departments or Centres;
- (v) appoint Committees from amongst the members of the Senate, other teachers of the School and experts from outside to advise on such specific and important academic matters as may be referred to any such Committee by the Senate:
- (vi) consider the recommendations of the Advisory Committees attached to various Departments or Centres and that of Expert and other Committees and take such action (including the making of recommendations to the Board) as warranted in each case:
- (vii) make periodical review of the activities of the Departments or Centres and take appropriate action (including the making of recommendations to the Board);
- (viii) supervise the working of the library of the School;
- (ix) promote research and academic development or activities within the School and seek reports on such research or academic development or activities from the persons engaged therein;
- (x) provide for the inspection of the class rooms, laboratories, library and the residential hostels;
- (xi) plan and supervise co-curricular activities of the students of the School;
- (xii) award stipends, scholarships, medals and prizes and make other awards in accordance with such conditions as may be attached to the awards;
- (xiii) make recommendations to the Board with regard to the creation or restructuring of Departments or Programmes or Centres

and the abolition of existing Departments or centres thereof;

(xiv) invite up to two student representatives during discussions of a general nature not involving policy or disciplinary matters in the Senate meetings.

## POWER OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

As per Statute 11 of the School of Planning and Architecture Statute, 2016, the Finance committee shall have power to:

- (i) examine and scrutinize the annual budget of the School prepared by Director and make recommendations to the Board;
- (ii) examine all proposals relating to revision of grade, upgradation of the scales and all those items which are not included in the budget, before they are considered by the Board:
- (iii) fix limits for the total recurring and non-recurring expenditure for the year, based on income and resources of the School:
- (iv) oversee that no expenditure shall be incurred by the School in excess of the limits so fixed; and
- (v) give its views and make its recommendations on any financial question affecting the School including all the proposals relating to Building and Works Committee of the School to the Board either on the initiative of the Board or of the Director, or on its own motion.

## POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BUILDING AND WORKS COMMITTEE

As per Statute 13 of the School of Planning and Architecture Statute, 2016, the Building and Works Committee shall have following powers and functions:-

- (1) The Building and Works Committee shall:-
  - (i) under the directions of the Board, examine and execute all the construction related projects and activities of the School upon receiving the financial sanctions from the Finance Committee and final administrative approval from the Board;
  - (ii) cause to prepare estimates of cost of buildings and other capital works, minor works, repairs, maintenance and the like;
  - (iii) be responsible for making technical scrutiny of the design, estimates and specifications of the material as may be considered necessary:
  - (iv) be responsible for acceptance of tenders and shall have the power to execute the departmental works wherever necessary as per extant rules of the Central Government or Central Public Works Department and relevant provisions of the General Financial Rules.
  - (v) have the power to give the necessary administrative approval and expenditure sanction for minor works pertaining to repair and maintenance, etc., upto Rs.10.00 Lacs, within the approved budgetary provision of the School.
- (2) If, in the opinion of the Chairman of the Building and Works Committee, any emergency has arisen which requires immediate action to be taken, he shall take such action and report the same to the Building and Works Committee, Finance Committee and the Board at their next meetings for ratification.
- (3) The Building and Works Committee shall also perform such functions and exercise such powers as may be entrusted by the Board, from time to time.
