| i) | PASS | Student is passed and promoted to the Next semester |
| ii) | C. O. | C.O. means Carry Over. The student is promoted to the next semester or year with Carrying Over Scheme as per rule 14.1 & 15.2 of the ordinance no.1. The student may reappear for the external examination of that course in the subsequent academic year. |
| iii) | WITHHELD | Result is withheld due to some specific reason and will be declared after the decision of Moderation Committee later on. |
| iv) | Failed as per rule 10 | A minimum of grade "D" is required to earn assign credits of any course on the basis of internal assessment and/or external examination as the case may be for 10 and IE courses respectively, whether it is a Theory paper or Jury or Viva-voce. A student not passing the course shall be awarded grade "F" and declared failed in that course. |
| v) | Failed as per rule 11.1 | A student declared failed with a "F" grade in any Jury examination, other than Thesis/Dissertation, shall not be promoted to the next higher year.. The student shall repeat the studio course along with the regular students in a subsequent academic year. |
| vi) | Failed as per rule 12.1 | A student declared failed with grade "F" will have to repeat the thesis/dissertation, on the same topic or a new topic, in a subsequent academic year along with regular students. |
| vii) | Incomplete "I" as per rule 12.3 | A student can be awarded a grade "I" for incomplete work and he shall appear for an Improvement Examination not later then three months from date of the first examination. Upon successful completion, the student shall be awarded a passing grade not higher then grade "C" |
| viii) | Failed/ DETAINED as per rule 8.3, 13.2 & 17.3 | The student is not promoted to the next semester or year and is DETAINED to repeat in the subject/s shown against their name in the subsequent year as per rule 8.3, 13.2 & 17.3. |
| IX) | DETAINED as per rule 17.1 | Student is not promoted to the next semester or year and is DETAINED to repeat all courses in a subsequent year as per rule 17 (i) Shortage of attendance and rule 7.1 & 7.2 Attendance requirement. |
| X) | Failed as per rule 26.2 (i) & DETAINED as/rule 17.5 | Student is not promoted to the next semester or year and is DETAINED to repeat in the subject/s shown against his/her name in the subsequent academic year as per rule 26.2 (i) Malpractice and Unfair Means and rule 17.5 of detention rule. |
| XI) | TIME BAR | As per rule no. 15.6, 19.1 & 19.4 of the Ordinance no. 1, the student has not passed the examinations within the prescribed time limit to continue the program. |
