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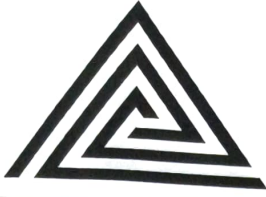

2. The site for the work shall be made available in parts. The contractor should inspect the site before quoting the rates and it will be sole responsibility of the contractor for making the safety arrangement of the incumbents of the school and the labour.

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3. The bidder must be registered with Income Tax, Service Tax/GST and must submit legible **scan & upload** copies of PAN/TIN No. and GST No. with Bid document. Bid without these documents will be rejected.
4. Contractor should have experience of having successful completed works during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which application are invited.
 - i. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of estimated cost put to E-Tender.
OR
 - ii. Two similar completed works ,each costing not less than the amount equal to 60% of the estimated cost put to E-Tender.
OR
 - iii. One similar completed work of cost not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
"Similar works meaning construction/maintenance of building civil works"
5. Bidders should note that SPA may verify authenticity of the document/certificate submitted by them in the tender. In case at any stage of tendering process of contract/PO execution, if it is established that the bidder has submitted forged documents /certificates in the tender than SPA shall take action to terminate the awarded contract and will forfeit the security deposits submitted by the bidder and other legal action can also be initiated against the bidder as deemed fit.
6. The Contractor shall at all stages of the work will deploy skilled /semi-skilled persons for the work who are qualified and possess certificate for the required trade in case of specialized works.
7. The Bidder should not have been blacklisted by Central/State Government Departments/ Public Sector Undertakings or other institutions. No conviction certificate duly signed by the bidder on their letter head has to be submitted to confirm it
8. It is mandatory to put a copy of the all documents submitted in the tender box presenting the Assistant Engineer's room before tender Submission Date

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The work shall be carried out according to CPWD specification for works. 2023 Volume I to Volume II, including correction slips upto date of submission of bid and specifications as per additional conditions given below.
2. The contractors shall quote their rates inclusive of all sorts of taxes, cartage, royalties etc, complete.
3. Unless otherwise specified, the agreement rates for all items of work of the schedule of quantities are for all heights, depths, leads and lifts involved in the execution of work.
4. The contractor shall make his own arrangement of water required for the work as per clause 31 of the general conditions of the contract for CPWD works and clause 31A of the said conditions stands deleted. However 1% (one percent) water charges shall be recovered on the gross amount of bill from the contractor, if government water issued.

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5. The contractor shall make his own arrangements for obtaining electric connection for carrying out any maintenance activity and make necessary payment directly to the department concerned. In the absence of electric connection or failure of power supply, the contractor shall make his own arrangement of generators.
6. Other agencies working at site will also simultaneously execute the work entrusted to them and the contractor shall offer necessary co-operation wherever required to other agencies.
7. On account of security consideration, there could be some restrictions on the working hours, movement of vehicles for transportation of materials. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions and adjust the programmer for execution accordingly.
8. The work shall be carried out in a manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant bye laws of the local bodies, labour laws, minimum wages act, workmen compensation act and other statutory laws enacted by Central Government as well as Stat Government.
9. All malba/rubbish/silt/waste/garbage etc. generated due to any operation from houses, office building and other open spaces whatsoever shall be disposed off on daily basis by the contractor to the specified common disposal point and nothing extra shall be paid on this account. After the collection of full truck load of the said malba (approx. 4.5 cubic meters), the same shall be disposed off by the contractor to the authorized municipal dhalao /dumping ground Within **Seven (7)** days. In case of non-removal/disposal within seven days period from the specified common disposal point in colony, a Penalty of Rs. 1000 (One Thousand) per day shall be recovered from the contractor.

(B) All the malba or rubbish obtained from dismantling or otherwise during the execution of work shall be collected in the mobile container arranged by contractor free of cost of suitable sized placed near the working place. The malba or building rubbish so collected shall be disposed off to the specified common disposal point in the campus.
10. No claims of the labour shall be entertained by the Department including that of providing employment, regularization of services etc.
11. The engineers who are present at the site from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM on all working days or as working hours allowed by Engineer-in-charge shall carry mobile telephone(s) to enable the Engineer-in-charge to have easy and quick communication. Nothing extra shall be paid to the contractor on this account and his quoted rates for various items under this contract will be inclusive of this obligation.
12. The staff employed by the contractor and contractor should be well behaved, Polite & courteous. Any complaint against staff on behavior should be taken very seriously and such should be removed by the contractor immediately from the site, otherwise the firm will be blacklisted from SPA.

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13. The contractor shall make all safety arrangement required for the Labour/Staff engaged by him at his own cost. All consequences due to negligence or due to lapse of security/safety or otherwise shall remain with the contractor. The department shall not be responsible for any mishap, injury, accident or death of the contractor's staff. No claim in this regard shall be entertained /accepted by the department.
14. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to govt. Property or allottees property by his labour/staff in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
15. GST/Income Tax/other taxes as applicable shall be recovered from the contractor's bill.
16. Chases, holes & drilling works etc. shall be done using power operated tools.
17. Dismantling of cement concrete slabs, floors etc. inside the quarters/building shall be done with the help of mechanized vibratory hammer, drills etc. The work shall be carried out in such a way that there should be least disturbance to the nearby/ adjoining allottees/occupants. The work should be completed within least possible time. The contractor must ensure that there should be no damaged to the supporting RCC/structural member of the buildings.
18. The contractor shall take all in safety precautionary measures to prevent any incident or accident causing injury /injuries to official/occupants of the area where work is being executed.
19. Contractor is required to take contractor's all risk policy or erection all risk policy (as the case may be) from an approved insurance company and bear all costs towards the same for the full period of execution of works including the defect liability period for the full amount of contract against all loss of damage from whatever cause arising other than excepted risks for which he is responsible under the terms of the contract Whenever required by SPA, the contractor shall produce the policy or the policies of insurance and the receipts for payment of the current premium.

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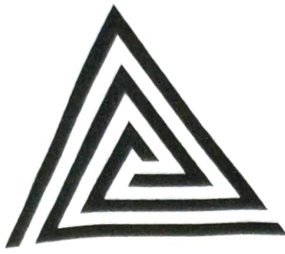
